MANCHESTER RUSHES FOR 'WE WILL ROCK YOU' TICKETS

More Demand For Seats In Manchester Than In London Says SeatChoice.com

We Will Rock You, the hit musical featuring the songs of Queen, comes to the Palace Theatre Manchester in March and according to theatre ticket comparison site SeatChoice.com there's been a huge demand for tickets.

The science fiction comedy written by Ben Elton and featuring songs such as 'We Are The Champions' and 'Radio GaGa' has played at London's Dominion Theatre since 2002 and a touring production of the smash hit show starts a nationwide tour at Manchester's Palace Theatre on the 20th of March. Searches for tickets to the Manchester production make it the most sought after show outside of London's West End, far outstripping demand for tickets to the original Dominion Theatre production and more popular than other London shows such as Mama Mia, Billy Elliot and Phantom of the Opera.

SeatChoice.com believes one of the reasons why there's been such a rush for tickets is the big difference in price between the Manchester production and the London production. Ticket prices for We Will Rock You at the Palace Theatre Manchester range from £14.50 in the grand tier to £40.00 in the stalls whilst tickets to see the show at the Dominion Theatre London range from £28.00 in the grand circle to £60.00 in the stalls.

Robert Iles, founder of theatre ticket comparison website SeatChoice.com said: 'Tickets to see We Will Rock You in Manchester cost between 30% and 50% less than if you saw the show in London so it's not surprising that Mancunians have jumped at the opportunity to see the show on their doorstep. However, it's already getting difficult to find seats in the first month of the run so if you want to go and see the show in Manchester, don't hang around, book it now!'

SeatChoice.com conducts real-time searches of theatre box offices and over 20 ticket outlets including leading ticket agents such as Ticketmaster and Keith Prowse, and secondary ticket suppliers such as Seatwave and Viagogo. Combined, SeatChoice's suppliers offer tickets to over 7600 plays, shows and concerts across the country.
